- GOOGLE: fsaid.ed.gov
- Create a FSA ID for yourself and your parent. You must have a different email for your parents. DO NOT USE YOUR SCHOOL EMAIL, IT WILL EXPIRE. USE A PERSONAL EMAIL.
- Make sure to write down both of your usernames and passwords along with the answers that you selected for each question.
- Keep your username and passwords in a secure place. You will use the same ones throughout your college career. THEY NEVER EXPIRE.
